

GUIDELINES

HALTERES--a peer reviewed journal (published annually by [Organisation on Conservation and Biodiversity-CSBD](#)) focuses mainly on entomological research from India and Indo-Malayan/Oriental region. The thrust areas include insect taxonomy, biogeography, ecology, ethology, genetics, physiology and conservation etc.

Only those manuscripts will be considered for publication, which provide the following declaration duly signed by all authors:

‘That the findings/interpretations presented in manuscript are original in nature except where stated otherwise and no part of work has been submitted for publication elsewhere, and that all authors have agreed to submission, hold ethical and moral responsibility regarding authenticity of work’.

FORMAT/PATTERN

1. Manuscripts should be submitted by email as MS-Word files along with one hard copy to be sent by surface mail.
2. Text should be typed in Palatino Linotype font (Regular) with font size 12 with 3cm margin on each side on A4 paper with all the pages numbered at the upper right hand corner.
3. Title should be concise and title page should contain keywords (not more than 6), with full names and addresses of authors.
4. Abstract should be on the second page with no more than 150 to 200 words reflecting the major outcome of the work to be published.
5. Digital photographs, graphs and hand drawings (scanned at 300dpi for clarity in publication) should be submitted in Tag Images File Format (TIFF). Figures, drawings and Digital images should be tagged with magnification line and should be numbered with Arabic numbers.
6. For measurements metric system(SI) should be used.
7. The use of species names should follow the ICZN 2000 (<http://www.iczn.org>).
8. References should be on the following pattern (full name of Journal should be given):
